- 2) Offer "No pressure" ministry opportunities (for just a season, or forever). These will include worship, discipleship, and mission.
- 3) Organize local groups of those who wish to remain UMC by proactively finding and connecting with individual persons and groups that feel displaced by disaffiliating churches.
- 4) <u>Connect persons or groups with Conference and District resources to help them discern their next steps as they consider a new church home.</u>
